



Dear MedSend Friend,

What a difference a year makes!

Last year as we closed our fiscal year on June 30 and surveyed the year ahead, there were "giants" in the land. With the faltering U.S. economy and increasing global political and economic turmoil, it almost seemed prudent to consider downsizing the ministry.

I say "almost" because God had other ideas. We believed the Lord was telling us to keep our eyes on Him, to trust in His protection and provision. So instead of scaling back, we continued taking grant applications and we redoubled our fundraising efforts.

Today I am happy to report that God has indeed blessed MedSend – and He has done this by working through the generosity of donors like you.

On June 30, 2011, we will close a fiscal year that has been a resounding success. While we did not quite make our budget, donations are up \$100,000 or 8% over the preceding year. In addition, our donor base has increased along with our organizational capacity.

Let's translate this into lives. Since last July we have begun making monthly educational loan payments on 25 new grants and we have renewed 25 existing grants – for a total commitment of \$2 million over the next four years. These grants have enabled 50 dedicated Christian healthcare professionals to serve in the areas where God has called them. Since one MedSend healthcare professional can provide compassionate care for thousands of people per year, these grants represent a lot of lives touched – and many transformed.

None of this would have been possible without God's blessing and your faithful support.

This year, as we look ahead, we still see many of the same giants – and a few new ones. These are challenges largely borne of MedSend's success. For example, thanks to our established reputation, we now have more grant applications than ever in the pipeline. And as a testimony to MedSend's support for long-term service, we anticipate that we will also have a record number of grant renewals in the coming year.

We are overjoyed by the mission God has set before us – even as we acknowledge that accomplishing it will not be easy.

Like Joshua in the Old Testament, we are determined to heed the Lord's command to "be strong and courageous." By faith, our board just approved a group of 12 grants and 4 renewals. By faith, we are working to secure more than \$600,000 in donations to fund these grants. By faith, we hold fast to our belief that once again, the Lord will not fail or forsake us – no matter what the future brings!

Thank you for your faithful support that made fiscal year 2011 such a blessing for so many. I hope that you will consider helping us to slay the "giants" in 2012 by making a special gift today.
